Job 29:11-16

When the ear heard, it commended me,
and when the eye saw, it approved;
because I delivered the poor who cried,
and the orphan who had no helper.
The blessing of the wretched came upon me,
and I caused the widow's heart to sing for
joy. I put on righteousness, and it clothed me;
my justice was like a robe and a turban.
I was eyes to the blind,
and feet to the lame.
I was a father to the needy,
and I championed the cause of the stranger.

1 Corinthians 13

If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of
angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy
gong or a clanging cymbal. And if I have
prophetic powers, and understand all
mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all
faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not
have love, I am nothing. If I give away all my
possessions, and if I hand over my body so
that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain
nothing.

Love is patient; love is kind; love is not
envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It
does not insist on its own way; it is not
irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in
wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears
all things, believes all things, hopes all things,

endures all things.

Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they
will come to an end; as for tongues, they will
cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an
end. For we know only in part, and we
prophesy only in part; but when the
complete comes, the partial will come to an
end. When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I
thought like a child, I reasoned like a child;
when I became an adult, I put an end to
childish ways. For now we see in a mirror,
dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now
I know only in part; then I will know fully,
even as I have been fully known. And now
faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and
the greatest of these is love.

John 14:1-6

'Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in
God, believe also in me. In my Father's house
there are many dwelling-places. If it were not
so, would I have told you that I go to prepare
a place for you? And if I go and prepare a
place for you, I will come again and will take
you to myself, so that where I am, there you
may be also. And you know the way to the
place where I am going.' Thomas said to him,
'Lord, we do not know where you are going.
How can we know the way?' Jesus said to
him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the
life. No one comes to the Father except
through me. If you know me, you will
know my Father also. From now on you do
know him and have seen him.'
